Bids will be received by the Guilford County School System until **2:00 pm on Tuesday, November 26, 2024**, at 501 W. Washington Street, Greensboro, NC 27401, to furnish all materials and labor for the Grimsley Senior High School, Chair Lift installation Project. Please allow sufficient time for this, as late bids will not be accepted.

A brief description of work in the project as follows:

Provide two new vertical lifts with all associated devices, wiring and conduit shall be installed. Replace 8 pairs of doors in existing frames. One classroom door/frame/transom is to be relocated. Work shall be installed, inspected and approved by the City of Greensboro/Guilford County Fire marshal's office.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at the project site at **4 pm Thursday, November 14, 2024**. Attendees should meet at the front of the Main Building at the school. Attendance at this conference is recommended for all potential bidders to examine the existing conditions and to discuss details of the project.

Bidders must be properly licensed for the work in accordance with Section 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes.

A 5% Bid Bond and 100% Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds are required for this project. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 60 days.

E-Verify Requirements: This project requires the awarded vendor to comply with the requirements of E-Verify. (U.S. law requiring companies to employ only individuals who may legally work in the United States – either U.S. citizens, or foreign citizens who have the necessary authorization.)

Minority businesses are encouraged to submit bids for this project. The appropriate forms from the section entitled "Participation by Women and Minority Owned Businesses" must be submitted with each bid to show good faith efforts to obtain Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprise participation.

The Guilford County Board of Education awards public contracts without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age or handicapped condition as defined by North Carolina General Statutes, Section 168A-3. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids presented and to waive any informalities and irregularities.
